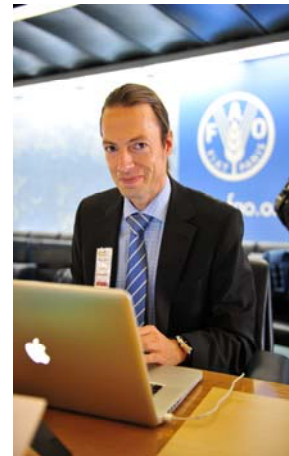


Tom Heilandt

Tom Heilandt was born on 30 December 1961 in Oberhausen, Germany. He holds a University Diploma in Mathematics and Computer Science. After graduation in 1989, Mr Heilandt worked in a University project on neural modelling at the Heinrich-Heine University Düsseldorf. In 1990, he joined Bayer AG (chemical industry) as Junior Executive, working in the IT Department. In 1992, he joined Trinzic (Deutschland) AG as software engineer responsible for customer relations and training.



In 1994 after passing the national competitive examination held by the United Nations Secretariat for nationals of Germany he joined the Secretariat of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) in Geneva as Associate Scientific Affairs Officer working on risk management and communication for international conventions and recommendations on the transport of dangerous goods. From 1998 to 2005 he served as Secretary to the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards and its specialized sections dealing with marketing standards for fruits and vegetables, dry and dried produce, seed potatoes and meat.

In 2005, Mr Heilandt joined the Codex Secretariat as Senior Food Standards Officer (P-5). He is specifically responsible for the communication, promotion and publication of the work of the Commission in addition to Codex work on Food Labelling, General Principles and the Coordinating Committee for the Near East. He was responsible as officer in charge for the organization and conduct of the 32nd Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission.
